## BOARD MEETING #1037

An Action meeting of the Board of School Directors of the North Penn School District was held at the Educational Service Center on Thursday, May 21, 2015.

The meeting was called to order by Vincent Sherpinsky, president, at 7:34p.m. Vincent Sherpinsky reminded those in attendance that the meeting was being videotaped by the school district for the community cable channel. Vincent Sherpinsky requested that members of the audience wishing to address the board should come to the microphone, state their name and address, sign the audience of citizens' logbook, and limit their questions and comments to permit time for all those who wished to speak to the board.
