MEAL CHARGING & NEGATIVE ACCOUNT BALANCES

Negative account balances impact our operating efficiency and forces us to potentially increase prices year to year. School Nutrition Services works diligently to recover negative balances. Therefore, negative balance notifications will be sent home weekly via email or letter. To avoid getting the weekly negative balance email, we suggest keeping meal accounts up-to-date.
